It is a matter of great pleasure that Prayas welfare school has been granted recognition by **Government of Haryana, Directorate School Education vide their letter No. PSR052023319** dated 03/10/2023 from 9th to 12th w.e.f 01/04/2024 while recognition was accorded from 1st to 8th in the year 2022 w.e.f. 01/04/2023. Hygiene Kit distribution

Medical Camps

Medical Camps were arranged by smile foundation for our students on 19/05/2023,28/08/2023 and 15/02/2024 wherein health Parameters were checked up like Height and weight, Eye Check-up, General physical examination and nutritional advice. After the check-ups , students who were anaemic or found iron or calcium deficient , were given medicines and tonics.

Other Activities and achievements



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1- Stem Lab and Smart Classes

On 1st February, in collaboration with Smile Foundation proudly inaugurated a STEM Lab . This ceremony was graced by representatives from Smile Foundation , A V Oil and members of Governing Body of Prayas Social Welfare Society. This lab is designed to inspire and educate students in the field of Science Technology, Engineering and mathematics.

2--JEE and NEET Coaching Classes

Encouraged by the result of our last batches wherein out of 2 in NEET aspirants, one succeeded and was admitted in MBBS and in JEE, six students succeeded and they were admitted in engineering classes in different reputed colleges, number of admissions in both the coaching classes particularly in NEET has considerably increased. In 2023-24 academic Session 18 children in NEET and 10 in JEE took coaching from our Prayas Social Welfare Society (Regd.). It is a matter of great pleasure that Out of these children 4 have been selected in NEET and 4 have been selected in JEE.

3--Internship

During the year 2023 -24, 32 students from various educational institutions like J C Bose university, Kurukshetra University, Dehradun and Christ University, have undergone their internship programme with our society. During their internship activities, interns are involved in several activities, such as educational support to children, Health awareness campaign, event Management, Multi Media etc. Thus they get opportunities to enhance leadership, organizational and team work skills.

4-- Placement

Six students who were the students of computer classes Under VTP of Prayas SWS after completion of the computer course, have got employment at various places like school, HR Roadways, HR Police, P F Office, Huda and Post office etc. From Beauty culture classes 5 students informed that they are earning 5 to 15 thousand per month. Out of 7, 3 students are the owner of their own beauty parlour and two are doing job in some other's beauty parlour on salary basis. We have the information of 6 students from Tailoring section that 4 students have opened their boutiques and2 students have joined job in IMT.

5-- Our students participated in various competition programs such as singing, drawing, besides sports on children day. A grand drawing competition was held at Kali Badi wherein participants from Prayas Welfare School were highly appreciated by the judges. Two participants of our school received special recognition and special award for their work.

6-- Parents meet were regularly held and they were educated to take care of their family's health and education of their children.

7—Prayas SWS in coordination with Smile Foundation organised a series of excursion/Exposure trip for the students on 27/09/2023,29/09/2023,28/02/2024 This trips aimed to provide practical learning, exposure to nature, and cultural heritage outside the class room.

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9-- Bharat Vikas Parishad organised two camps during the said financial year for our students. Objectives of Camps were to instil a sense of National Pride, responsibility opportunities for leadership development, teamwork and discipline. Camps organised JUDO sessions exclusively for girls, for self-Protection, promoting confidence physical fitness and empowerment.
